Nature of position involves exposure to health and safety risks on a continuous basis. Both, physical injury and exposure to contagious diseases exist. Must be able to engage with combative individuals. Must maintain a physical standard and competency to use physical force (run, strike, fight, control, use impact weapons, chemical agents and firearms) and verbal techniques. Must demonstrate physical force competence and proficiency on a regular basis. Operates a patrol vehicle under stressful circumstances, in all weather conditions.
